

Florida Kris Kringle

Visitation Checklist

- Prepare for Florida Kris Kringle's arrival. Reserve a special parking spot close enough, but out of view of your family and/or guests.
- Have a greeter standing by with an umbrella if it's raining.
- See to it that everyone is ready prior to Florida Kris Kringle's arrival. You can arrange to have him call you when he's five minutes away.
- Have your gifts ready for distribution.
- Make sure they are legibly labeled. Difficult pronunciations should be communicated with Florida Kris Kringle's elves prior to the visit.
- Have your cameral ready.
- Be sure your batteries are fresh or fully charged and you have sufficient space on your memory card.
- Have a special chair for Florida Kris Kringle that's sturdy and capable of supporting him and a child on each knee.
- We recommend also having a small chair next to Florida Kris Kringle for children who might be a bit shy to sit on Florida Kris Kringle's lap.
- Place the chair near the Christmas tree or in a Holiday setting. Leave a foot or two between the chair and the tree or backdrop to allow for additional room for group photos.
- If you have a large group, have a way to control the crowd such as a line, or use assistants or helpers.
- Make sure that children's faces and hands are clean. Having wipes handy is always a good idea.
- For extended visits, a secluded break area should be identified.
- When paying your balance place it inside a Christmas card or envelope. When giving it to Florida Kris Kringle simply say something like, "Here is a Christmas card for you and Mrs. Claus."

Visitation Rules

- Florida Kris Kringle needs hourly breaks - ten minutes for every one hour of sitting. A private break area with water will be needed.
